

Campus Crime and Security Act

American University of Health Sciences is in compliance with the Campus Crime and Security Act of 1990 and publishes an annual report on approximately October 1 of each year. This annual disclosure is designed to provide transparency regarding campus safety, enabling students and their families to be informed about potential risks and the security measures in place at their chosen institution. Both acts play a key role in ensuring that students have the necessary information to make informed choices about their education and campus environment.

Safety Information

The security of all members of the campus is a primary concern to the University. Each year, AUHS publishes a report outlining security and safety information and crime statistics for the campus community. This report provides important policy information about emergency procedures, reporting of crimes, and information about support services for victims of sexual assault.
